

# MULTIPLYING IMPACT

Transformed women leaders bring transformation of lives, leaders, communities and nations



## Results of Women Trained



Women are disciple-making disciples of Christ



Women are leaders who have significant influence in their homes, churches, and communities



Women are given the ability to successfully start and operate their own business



Women learn principles of wholistic health; nutrition, hygiene and preventative health practices



Women are released from captivity and become a voice for the voiceless

Jesus spoke and lived God's word in principle and practice. So must we. His word teaches us to love one another, care for another, encourage and build up one another, as we are all created in His image, both male and female. Each Women in the Window training includes God's Word relevant to each topic and an inductive Bible study of one woman in the Bible. Through the "windows" of inductive Bible study women see for themselves just how valuable they truly are!

Today in most nations of the world, women are treated as property, frequently abused and often the poorest of the poor, living well below the poverty line. They are denied health care, education and sometimes even food — eating last and less. The example of our Lord Jesus Christ stands in direct contrast to these cultural and religious norms which subjugate and harm women and girls. He included women as prayer partners, supporters and front-line disciples. As we follow in His steps in the 10/40 Window and beyond, we replace poverty and injustice with dignity and purpose in Christ.

Here's how it works:

- Our Ministry Partner (MP) requests training
- WiW and MP work together to choose dates
- MP chooses one of our training capacities: Head, Heart, Hands, Health or Advocacy
- WiW assigns a Servant Leader and assembles a team
- WiW team completes training
- MP determine best follow-up strategy
- MP and WiW plan their next training capacity

Mary (story appears on next page) received multiple trainings, then returned to her refugee camp after the WiW training to train 12 more women in leadership and economic empowerment. These 12 train more women, who will train 12 more. This is multiplied many times over as  $12 \times 12 \times 12 = 1728$  and continues to grow and multiply.

God's mathematics far surpass anything we can ask, think or imagine! In Ephesians 3:20 He reminds us that, **"He is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine..."**

# STORIES OF HOPE

## AMEERA

Growing up in a close and loving Muslim family in Algeria, Ameera felt her life was destroyed when she was forced to marry a man she neither knew nor loved. Ameera couldn't believe that her family would set her up with such a man. She couldn't seem to get past this betrayal.

Through the quiet witness of neighbors and radio broadcasts, she came to know Jesus Christ and His great love for her. When her husband learned of this, he took their son and locked her in a bedroom until she would repent of this new religious belief. Through months of trial, she never denied her Lord. Eventually, her husband divorced her and she moved to Europe.

This spring she attended a WIW training session on leadership. She discovered that she has a passion to lead other women in Bible study and spiritual growth. She desires to be a woman who "turns the world upside down" for Jesus.

## KAUSHMILA

Kaushmila lives in a remote area in the hill country of East Nepal. Her people are illiterate, and also don't believe women should have equal rights. As a result, women are oppressed, even in Christian families. Two years ago, Kaushmila's husband left for Malaysia for employment. She has not heard from him, and he has not sent money back to her. She knows that he is alive because her in-laws have heard from him.

This situation has left her trapped, unable to earn money herself since women are not encouraged to work outside of the home, and unable to move on since she has few rights. However, she attended the 1-month training and the WIW 3-day Leadership training. She is gaining confidence that God can and does use women in His kingdom, and she is helping to lead a training in her region so that other women will learn their value in God's eyes.

## MARY

Mary has lived in a small village near Juba, South Sudan, all of her life. As a young girl she accepted Jesus as her Savior. She was able to complete high school, and married a pastor. While she rejoices in the Lord's protection, she has experienced the loss of her father and several brothers due to recent wars.

Pastor A. and Mary have adopted 7 orphaned nieces and nephews and are raising them together with their own 6 children.

Mary has attended WiW trainings in microenterprise, leadership, and spiritual growth. She is now able to help her own family financially. By sharing what she has learned about the Lord, leadership, and small business, she is also teaching groups of 12 women in the refugee camp where she lives.
