The Sahel is the semi-arid region stretching the full width of Africa from the Atlantic Ocean to the Red Sea. The Sahel, a large component of the western third of the 10/40 Window, stands today as one of the most spiritually needy areas of the world. The turmoil in the Sahel over the past decade has severely limited mission activity, and many areas are now closed to or dangerous for such outreach. How can we serve and disciple these many countries and peoples? Through locally led ministries such as Amevívina Care!

Ghana women suffer from gender prejudice and were subject to domestic violence, human trafficking and financial burden when they rejected gender roles. Instead of receiving an education or gaining individual capital, Ghanaian women learn to fulfill familial duties of motherhood and caretaking while upholding their husband's lineage. The 2000 Ghana Living Standards Survey reported [44.1% of women](#) were lacking formal education compared to 21.1% of men. (Borgen Project, June 8, 2021)
